SUBJECT: REPEAL: Check Printer and Check Number Act

On June 30, 2017, Governor Rauner signed into law HB1783. The Check Printer and Check Number Act (205 ILCS 690) was repealed, eliminating the requirement for registrations to be filed with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, Division of Banking. Effective immediately, any person or entity who sells or distributes checks is no longer required to complete registrations or annual registration renewals.
