**PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, the Division of Banking has found that, on December 15, 2016, a power failure related emergency existed interfering physically with conduct of normal business operations that caused the branch office location at 117 E. Main St., Heyworth, Illinois of the First State Bank of Bloomington to close for all or part of the normal business day.

THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 2 of the Banking Emergencies Act [205 ILCS 610/2], the Division of Banking did find that an emergency existed and did grant the First State Bank of Bloomington authorization to close the operations that it conducts at its branch office located at 117 E. Main St., Heyworth, Illinois for all or part of the normal business day of December 15, 2016.
