### VARIANCE

Pursuant to the authority granted to me by 68 Illinois Administrative Code 1130.600, I hereby grant a Variance to any applicant for a license administered by the Division of Professional Regulation who is seeking to restore an expired or inactive license and who is subject to an increased fee or late fee.

The purpose of this Variance is to vary any rule that provides for an increased fee or late fee for an applicant where that fee has increased or a late fee has come into play during the pendency of the applicant's application with the Division through no fault of the applicant. Any affected applicant shall be responsible only for paying the fee in effect at the time of application. I find an emergency operational need to avoid an undue hardship on certain affected applicants.

This Variance is in no way intended to waive or modify any statute or other rule or regulation concerning the licensure, collection of licensing fees, or practice of professions licensed by the Division. Persons licensed in any affected profession shall comply with all additional rules and regulations contained in their respective Act and the rules promulgated thereto.

I have determined that the provision from which this Variance is granted is not statutorily mandated; no member of the public will be substantially injured by the granting of this Variance; and the rules from which this Variance is granted would be unreasonable or unnecessarily burdensome for the licensed profession to comply with for the duration of the emergency operational need.
