ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY

The Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, Division of Banking (the "Department"), having conducted an examination of facts related to Streator Cash Express, Streator, Illinois, and having found that Streator Cash Express (PWN.211) has committed a violation of 38 Ill. Admin. Code § 360.160(b), a rule that has been promulgated in accordance with the Pawnbroker Regulation Act [205 ILCS 510/0.01 to 510/15] (the "Act"), hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided by Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department FINDS the following:

- 1. Streator Cash Express operates a business located at 1408 N. Bloomington Street, Streator, Illinois.
- 2. Streator Cash Express held a license as a pawnbroker that expired on June 30, 2011.
- 3. Streator Cash Express elected to file an application to renew its pawnbroker's license through the period ending on June 30, 2012.
- 4. The renewal application filed by Streator Cash Express with the Department was faxed on June 3, 2011.
- 5. 38 Ill. Admin. Code § 360.160(b) provides that all applications for license renewal for the succeeding license period must be mailed and postmarked no later than June 1 of each year.
- 6. 38 Ill. Admin. Code § 360.160(b) further provides that a Late Filing Fee of \$50 per day shall be assessed for all applications postmarked after June 1 of each year, unless an exception has been granted.
- 7. Streator Cash Express has not been granted an exception by the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the above Findings of Fact, the Department CONCLUDES that:

Streator Cash Express has failed to meet the deadline set forth in 38 Ill. Admin. Code § 360.160(b).

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Streator Cash Express shall be and hereby is assessed a CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY in the amount of \$100 pursuant to Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act;
- 2. The CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY in the amount of \$100 shall be paid no later than sixty (60) days after service of this Order upon Streator Cash Express; and
- 3. The CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY in the amount of \$100 shall be made payable to the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation.
