ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY

The Secretary of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (the “Secretary”), having conducted an examination of facts related to Delgado Jewelry, Joliet, Illinois, and having found that Delgado Jewelry has committed violations of Section 0.05(c) of the Pawnbroker Regulation Act [205 ILCS 510/0.01 to 510/11] (the “Act”), hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided by Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Secretary FINDS the following:

1. Delgado Jewelry operates a business located at 451 North Collins Street, Joliet, Illinois.
2. Delgado Jewelry is lending money on the deposit or pledge of physically delivered personal property and is dealing in the purchase of personal property on the condition of selling the property back again at a stipulated price.
3. The Secretary has not issued Delgado Jewelry a license to conduct a business as a pawnbroker.
4. Section 0.05(c) of the Act provides that it is unlawful to operate a pawnshop without a license issued by the Secretary.
5. Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act provides the Secretary the authority to impose civil penalties against any person for each violation of any provision of the Act.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the above Findings of Fact, the Secretary CONCLUDES:

That Delgado Jewelry has violated Section 0.05(c) of the Act.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Delgado Jewelry shall be and hereby is assessed a CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY in the amount of \$765.00 pursuant to Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act;
2. The CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY in the amount of \$765.00 shall be paid no later than sixty (60) days after service of this Order upon Delgado Jewelry; and
3. The CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY in the amount of \$765.00 shall be satisfied by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation.
