**ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL MONETARY PENALTY**

The ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION (the "Department"), by and through his delegated representative having conducted an examination of facts related to Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop, 1504 11th St, Rock Island, IL ("Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop"), and having found that Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop (License No. PWN.0000327) has committed a violation of the rules related to the reporting requirements for pawnbrokers, hereby issues this ORDER pursuant to the authority provided under Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Pawnbroker Regulation Act [205 ILCS 510/0.01 *et seq.*] (the "Act").

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Department FINDS the following:

1. 38 Ill. Adm. Code, Part 360, comprises administrative rules related to the licensing and regulation of pawnbrokers in the State of Illinois;
2. Pursuant to 38 Ill. Adm. Code, Section 360.210(a), a pawnshop must file an annual report with the Department, on a form provided by the Department and entitled "Pawnshop Disclosure of Business Activities Report" ("Disclosure Report"), no later than 30 calendar days following the end of each calendar year;
3. According to the postmark on the envelope, Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop filed its Disclosure Report on February 1, 2012, 2 days after the filing deadline; and

4. Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act provides the Department the authority to assess a Civil Monetary Penalty against any person for each violation of any provision of the Act, any rule promulgated in accordance with the Act, or any order of the Department.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the Findings of Fact, the Department CONCLUDES that:

By virtue of its failure to timely file its Disclosure Report for calendar year 2011, Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop violated 38 Ill. Adm. Code, Section 360.210(a).

### **NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**


1. Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop shall be and hereby is assessed a Civil Monetary Penalty in the amount of \$100 (\$50 per day for 2 days) pursuant to Section 0.05(a)(6) of the Act;
2. The Civil Monetary Penalty in the amount of \$100 shall be paid no later than sixty (60) days after service of this order upon Tony's 11th St. Pawn Shop; and
3. The Civil Monetary Penalty in the amount of \$100 shall be paid by means of a certified check or money order made payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR).
