SUBJECT: Community Banking in the 21st Century Survey

State bank departments across the country in coordination with the Federal Reserve are planning the [fourth annual](#) Community Banking in the 21st Century research and policy conference. The goal of the conference is to provide a venue and encourage research on community banking. This research is a critical component to improving public policy as it relates to community banks and local communities. The Department of Financial and Professional Regulation is fully supportive of the future of community banking and believes that the completion of the survey will help the banking industry and regulators better understand the current issues facing community banks.

For last year's conference, state regulators conducted a nationwide survey of community banks with approximately 1,000 banks participating.
