Springfield, Illinois -- Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department for the month of **August 2000**.

ACCOUNTANT

James Buishas, Naperville – ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice of public accounting and pay a civil penalty of \$3,000.

Michael Paul Graham, Rantoul – public accountant license (065-008989) reprimanded for issuing an audit report that did not comply with current reporting standards for government audits.

Fitch & Fitzgerald, Springfield – design firm registration (184-000292) reprimanded and fined \$1,500 for allegedly operating a second location in Champaign from which it offered architectural services without a resident architect.
