

**ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION  
DISCIPLINARY REPORT FOR AUGUST 1999**

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**Springfield, Ill., September 1999** -- Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department for the month of **August 1999**.
