

**ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION
MONTHLY DISCIPLINARY REPORT FOR SEPTEMBER 2001**

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Springfield, Illinois – Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **September 2001**.

ACCOUNTANT

Robert Lee Howze Jr., Olympia Fields – public accountant license (065-027365) issued and placed on probation concurrent with disciplines imposed in North Carolina and Georgia.

**ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS
AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS**

Adam Skinner, Arlington Heights, and ARS A Development Compay, Arlington Heights – ordered to cease and desist the unlicensed practice of architecture and ordered to pay a civil penalty of \$500 total for offering architectural services without a license.

BOXING & WRESTLING

Roger Bloodworth, Glen Carbon – boxing second license (002-102070) reprimanded and fined \$100 for unprofessionally interfering in a boxing event in which his fighter was participating.

BARBER, COSMETOLOGY, ESTHETICS AND NAIL TECHNOLOGY

Herbert Frazier, Chicago – barber license (006-055990) suspended for six months and fined \$175 for allowing an unlicensed individual to practice as a barber at Herbert's Barber Shop and threatening a Department investigator during the investigation.

DENTAL

MEDICAL

Evangelina Belizario, Hinsdale – physician and surgeon license (036-056189) reprimanded for allegedly delaying transmitting patient medical records.

Arthur Bloch, Vernon Hills – physician and surgeon license (036-056903) placed on indefinite probation for engaging in unethical conduct by requesting some adolescent patients to undress for weigh-ins prior to psychotherapy sessions.

Albert Brown, Chicago – medical (036-059317) and controlled substance licenses revoked due to a felony conviction for possession of a firearm. While in custody for an outstanding warrant in Lake County, Brown's clinic remained open for business with two certified nursing assistants at the facility. Brown continued to prescribe, sell and administer prescription drugs to patients without examining the patients, and failed to maintain a log for controlled substances dispensed to patients.

Nathaniel Deere Greenberg, Chicago – medical (036-036225) and controlled substance licenses reprimanded for allegedly lacking medical records for a patient relating to prescribing controlled substances for a period of time.

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Leopoldo L. Juardo, Chicago – physician and surgeon license (036-046175) reprimanded for allegedly failing to properly interpret pap smears and diagnose cervical cancer in a timely manner resulting in the death of the patient.

Kurt Savegnago, Canton – physician and surgeon license (036-067859) reprimanded for over prescribing controlled substances to chronic pain patients and patients with known drug addictions.

Russell Zack, Rochelle – physician and surgeon license (036-028247) indefinitely suspended for failing to perform a C-section in a timely manner on a patient giving birth to a child and failing to respond in a timely manner to a request for information from the Department.

NURSING
