

**ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION
MONTHLY DISCIPLINARY REPORT FOR OCTOBER 2001**

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Springfield, Illinois – Leonard A. Sherman, Director of the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation, announced the following disciplinary actions taken by the Department during the month of **October 2001**.

ACCOUNTANT

Lisa M. Cano, Batavia - public accountant license (065-024615) reprimanded for practicing on a non-renewed license.

**ARCHITECTS, LAND SURVEYORS, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS
AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS**

Nancy L. Boyer, Springfield – professional engineer license (062-047249) indefinitely suspended after pleading guilty to one count of mail fraud.

David W. Crookall, Chicago – architect license (001-011492) reprimanded and fined \$5,000 for practicing on a non-renewed license for approximately 10 years.

ATHLETIC TRAINING

Charles John Gillette, Hoffman Estates – athletic trainer license (096-001560) issued with reprimand and fined \$100 for practicing as an athletic trainer without a license for approximately four months.

BOXING & WRESTLING

Eric Moon, Chicago – ordered to cease and desist from promoting Ironheart Crown events and from holding any ultimate fighting contests.

BARBER, COSMETOLOGY, ESTHETICS AND NAIL TECHNOLOGY

Adams 3 Barber Shop, Oak Park – barber shop license (189-004323) reprimanded and fined \$300 for allowing three unlicensed individuals to practice as barbers.

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Donna Marie Bavaro, Des Plaines – cosmetologist license (011-158262) placed in refuse to renew status for being more than 30 days delinquent in the payment of child support.

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DENTAL

Amos Rehberger, Anna – dentist license (019-010170) fined \$30,000 for practicing dentistry by performing a tooth extraction, prescribing antibiotics for himself and prescribing antibiotics for two patients while his license was suspended.

DETECTIVE, ALARM, SECURITY AND LOCKSMITH

Gregory R. Cole, Crystal Lake – permanent employee registration card (129-198148) indefinitely suspended for failing to pay Illinois income taxes from 1993 through 1999.

Michael Daniels Sr., Chicago – permanent employee registration card (129-246796) issued and placed on probation for two years due to criminal conviction history.

Ariel Gomez, Chicago – permanent employee registration card (129-246798) issued and placed on probation for one year for failing to disclose criminal conviction history.

Per Mar Investigation Service Inc., Loves Park, and Harold Finch, East Moline – Per Mar Investigation Service's private security contractor agency license (122-000289) placed on probation for two years and fined \$9,000, and Harold Finch's private security contractor license (119-000644) placed on probation for two years and fined \$5,000, after a Department audit revealed the company employed more than 90 individuals whose permanent employee registration card applications were not filed in a timely manner, employing more than 20 employees who did not have active permanent employee registration cards or pending applications, employing three individuals whose permanent employee registration card applications had been denied, and employing more than 30 individuals whose permanent employee registration cards were in a non-renewed status. Finch is the licensee-in-charge of Per Mar Investigation Service.

Michael Weatherl, Lincoln, NE – private security contractor license (119-000728) placed on probation for one year and fined \$1,950 for employing 45 individuals who did not have active permanent employee registration cards or pending applications, employing 20 individuals whose applications had not been submitted in a timely manner, and employing five individuals whose permanent employee registration cards were in a non-renewed status, while he was licensee-in-charge of Silverhawk Security Specialists Inc., located in Beardstown.

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Johnny Wright, Chicago – permanent employee registration card (129-007288) and firearm authorization cards (229-005926 and 229-050286) revoked after falsifying a firearm authorization card application indicating that he had never held an Illinois license or had a license which had been disciplined.

MEDICAL
