CONSUMER CREDIT

QC Financial Services, Inc., Waukegan - PLRA license (1265) fined \$43,650 for the following violations: lender did not verify that the loan was permissible, lender did not enter into the database that the borrower's loan was paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made, lender made a payday loan that resulted in the borrower having outstanding payday loan(s) more than 45 consecutive days, loans over 25% of borrower's income, lender made a payday loan resulting in the borrower having a combined outstanding payday loan principal balances greater than 25% of borrower's gross monthly income, lender did not properly enter loan(s) into the database on the day made, and official income documentation was not the required type for a payday loan or was not for income for the 30 days preceding the loan.

American General Financial Services of Illinois, Inc., Galesburg - CILA license (937) fined \$40,000 for failure to contain evidence of a contract signed or acknowledged by the borrower in the file.

America's Financial Choice, Inc., Chicago - PLRA license (1282) fined \$5,000 for the following violations: lender did not verify that the loan was permissible, lender did not enter into the database the borrower's loan was paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made, lender charged more than \$15.50 per \$100 loaned on a payday loan, and official income documentation was not the required type for a payday loan or was not for income for the 30 days preceding the loan.

Illinois Title Loans, Inc., McHenry - PLRA license (1427) fined \$4,500 for lender presenting dishonored check, ACH debit, or other item more than twice.

ACE Cash Express, Inc., d/b/a ACE Cash Advance, Loves Park - PLRA license (1408) fined \$4,000 for lender presenting dishonored check, ACH debit, or other item more than twice.

Check Into Cash of Illinois, d/b/a Check Into Cash, Des Plaines – PLRA license (1210) fined \$3,975 for the following violations: the loan document or other legal instrument contains blanks, original documents, or approved equivalent, not cancelled or returned following payoff, lender did not enter into the database that the borrower’s loan was paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made, a partial payment on a PLRA loan or repayment plan was not entered into the database on the date the transaction was made, and official income documentation was not the required type for a payday loan or was not for income for the 30 days preceding the loan.

America’s Financial Choice, Inc., Chicago - PLRA license (1286) fined \$3,900 for the following violations: lender did not verify that the loan was permissible, lender did not enter into the database that the borrower’s loan was not paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made, lender did not obtain any official documentation of the borrower’s income before making a payday loan, and lender made a payday loan with a term less than 13 days long.

Budget Finance Corporation, Aurora - CILA license (807) fined \$3,750 for failure to enter into database that the borrower’s loan was paid in full or cancelled on the day the transaction was made.

The Payday Loan Store of Illinois, Inc., Burbank - PLRA license (1306) fined \$2,000 for the following violations: security is not properly disclosed, interest rate is insufficient, and evidence of a signed or acknowledged truth-in lending disclosure is not in the file of original papers.

QC Financial Services, Inc., Berwyn - CILA license (2254) fined \$1,350 for the following violations: security is not properly disclosed and wage assignment was accepted from borrower that contained blank spaces.

QC Financial Services, Calumet City - CILA license (2247) fined \$1,200 for failure to properly disclose security.

R&L Webb Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a Hamilton County loan Company, McLeansboro - CILA license (2509) fined \$1,100 for the following violations: licensee did not send borrower a notice of the right to redeem with all required information, licensee did not deliver or mail to the borrower an affidavit of defense, date of repossession not available, licensee did not give written notice of intended sale/disposition or repossessed collateral including all required information, licensee did not send borrower notice of intended sale/disposition of collateral via certified mail, licensee did not dispose of reposed collateral in a commercially reasonable manner, repossession file does not contain signed receipts showing all collateral purchased, the amount paid and the name of the obligor, repossession file does not indicate a statement of final accounting containing the required information was sent to the borrower, repossession file does not contain a copy of the condition of collateral at time of repossession, the wording required by this section was not used in the sale of the collateral, and the licensee did not have receipts to document charges in connection with the sale of collateral.

Lighthouse Financial group of IL, Inc., Oak Lawn - CILA license (1965) fined \$1,050 for the following violations: the annual percentage rate is not accurately disclosed, improper simple interest calculations, and the loan contract does not accurately disclose the schedule of payments or the total of payments.

Vruno, Geneva – insurance producer license revoked after revealing Mr. Vruno had been permanently prohibited from offering or selling any securities in the State of Illinois and his registration as a salesperson of securities in the State of Illinois was revoked May 24, 2002 by the Illinois Secretary of State; misappropriated more than \$40,000.00 from a consumer; claimed

bankruptcy on fiduciary monies; and failed to repay the consumer and company when payment was requested.
