CONSUMER CREDIT

Express Auto Title Loans, Inc., 251 East Dundee Road, Wheeling – CILA License (2071) fined \$15,400 for the following violations: The title-secured loan or refinancing agreement did not contain the required initialed statement providing DFI's toll-free number to call for Debt Management Service information, the title-secured loan agreement did not contain a separate statement signed by the borrower that he/she has not had an outstanding title-secured loan in the last 15 days, the title-secured loan agreement did not prominently disclose DFI's address and phone number and advise the borrower of the right to report lending and collection violations, the lender took security other than the vehicle on a title-secured loan, title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's appropriate or most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, a title-secure lender made an additional loan to borrower who had an outstanding title-secured loan within the preceding 115 days, and security was not released.

Illinois Title Loans, Inc., Title Loans of America, 2950 South MacArthur Boulevard, Springfield – CILA License (1771) fined \$5,075 for the following violations: Licensed location was not maintaining posted hours, the loan register or transaction register was not properly maintained, licensee did not disclose on delinquency notices for title-secured loans the availability of debt management information at DFI's toll-free number, the title secured loan agreement did not contain a separate instrument signed by the borrower that he/she has not had an outstanding title-secured loan in the last 15 days, title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's appropriate or most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, licensee did not give written notice of intended sale/disposition of repossessed collateral including all required information, repossession file did not contain a copy of the condition of collateral at time of repossession, and the title-secured lender took possession of the vehicle without sufficient prior written notice to the borrower that included the borrower's right to make the vehicle available to the lender and obtain personal belongings without additional charge.

Illinois Title Loans, Inc., Title Loans of America, 1920 North Milwaukee Avenue, Chicago – CILA License (1955) fined \$2,050 for the following violations: Documentation was not in file to indicate lien was released and title returned to the obligor on title-secured loan

within 24 hours or 5 days if paid by check, title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's appropriate or most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, and licensee did not deliver or mail to the borrower an affidavit of defense.

Illinois Title Loans, Inc., Title Loans of America, 3159 West Cermak Avenue, Chicago – CILA License (1781) fined \$1,000 for failure to obtain any official documentation of the borrower's income before making a pay-day or title secured loan.

Illinois Title Loans, Inc., Title Loans of America, 3113 Broadway, Mount Vernon – CILA License (2124) fined \$1,000 for making an additional loan to a borrower who had an outstanding title-secured loan within the preceding 15 days.

Title Cash of Illinois, Inc., d/b/a Cash-2-Go, 2935 Clearlake Avenue, Suite 2A, Springfield – CILA License (2749) fined \$1,150 for the following violations: Licensee did not disclose on delinquency notices for title-secured loans the availability of debt management information at DFI's toll-free number, make, model, year and VIN of automobile was not on the title-secured loan document, documentation was not in file to indicate lien was released and title returned to the obligor on title-secured loan within 24 hours or 5 days if paid by check, and title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's appropriate or most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made.

Title Cash of Illinois, Inc., d/b/a Cash-2-Go, 1300 East Washington Street, East Peoria – CILA License (2095) fined \$1,100 for the following violations: Documentation was not in file to indicate lien was released and title returned to the obligor on title-secured loan within 24 hours or 5 days if paid by check, title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's appropriate or most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made, licensee did not send borrower a Notice of Right to Redeem with all required information, and licensee did not deliver or mail to the borrower an affidavit of defense.

Title Lenders, Inc., d/b/a USA Payday Loans, 1845 Broadway, Quincy – CILA License (2158) fined \$5,000 for the following violations: Lender made a title-secured loan with a scheduled monthly payment exceeding 50% of the obligor's gross monthly income and title-secured lender did not obtain borrower's appropriate or most recent income documentation available at the time the loan was made.
