Attention: The Illinois Professionals Health Program (“IPHP”) is transitioning out of Advocate Medical Group.

IPHP clients, please be aware that you will receive two mailings in the near future regarding this transition.

The first mailing will include a copy of your Agreement. Please keep this copy as documentation of your participation in the IPHP in case it is requested of you during this transition.

The second mailing will include new contact information, a summary of your toxicology report and an additional [release](#) that IPHP will request you sign and return immediately. This [release](#) will allow IPHP access to your records (with Advocate) for the purpose of submitting the reports needed for your ongoing advocacy.

IPHP is a confidential resource for physicians and other licensed healthcare professionals with substance use disorders, physical illnesses and mental health problems. It coordinates the evaluation, treatment and monitoring of professionals with these conditions. For many years IPHP has partnered with IDFPR to ensure that the safety of the public is protected while the healthcare professional is undergoing treatment and/or in recovery from their potentially impairing conditions.

Please note: There will be no impact to those individuals currently under an agreement with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (“IDFPR”).
